

**Latest motion and decision as of 8 Feb 2014:**

“MOTION MADE/SECONDED BY DAUSMAN AND ASPINWALL THAT :

BASED UPON THE RECENT COMMUNICATIONS WITH THE ARRL, PAVE PAWS MITIGATION CONTINUES TO BE IMPORTANT AND NECESSARY.

THE PRESENT PROCESS INVOLVING THE COORDINATION OF 420-450 OPERATIONS THAT MAY ALSO INVOLVE PAVE PAWS MITIGATION ISSUES WILL CONTINUE TO BE HANDLED AS BEFORE, WITH THE 440 COORDINATOR.

AN APPLICANT NOT HAPPY WITH THE DECISION OF THE 440 COORDINATOR ON PAVE PAWS MITIGATION ISSUES, MAY SUBMIT THEIR SYSTEM INFORMATION AND OTHER PERTINENT DATA TO THE ARRL FOR REVIEW WITH A COPY OF THE REQUEST TO THE 440 COORDINATOR. THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE ARRL HAS PRECEDENCE OVER THE DECISION OF THE NARCC COORDINATOR.

DURING THE PERIOD OF TIME THE APPLICATION IS UNDER REVIEW BY THE ARRL, THE APPLICATION FOR COORDINATION WILL REMAIN IN “PENDING” STATUS.”
